

### Bluetooth Remote Control

- Step 1. Go to Apps Center > RC BT Pairing
- Step 2. Press and hold the (+) and (=) buttons simultaneously for 3 seconds
- Step 3. Pairing successful

### **NOMVDIC Remote Control App**

- Step 1. Download the NOMVDIC Remote Control app onto your smartphone App Store Google Play
- Step 2. Connecting your phone and the projector to the same Wi-Fi Network
- Step 3. Open the NOMVDIC Remote Control app and select the projector (NOMVDIC XXXX)

# **Initial Setup**

### **Turning on R150**

- Step 1. Connect the power cord to R150
- Step 2. Fully charge R150 upon initial use. The light indicator next to the volume button will show the battery capacity. It takes about 3 hours to fully charge the projector
- Step 3. Switch the Power Toggle to the ON position
- Step 4. A solid green light will stay on after the startup

# Using R150 as a Projector

# Adjusting the Projected Image

#### Front, Side, and Ceiling Projection

Spin the projector to the angle that best fits your use scenario.

### Adjust the Keystone

The Auto Vertical Keystone will automatically correct the vertical keystone. To adjust the horizontal keystone:

- Step 1. In Home > Settings, go to Basic Settings
- Step 2. In Basic Settings > Keystone, select H Keystone to adjust the horizontal keystone

Alternatively, you can click 4 Corner Adjustment to adjust the projected image.

### **Fine-Tuning the Image Clarity**

To adjust the focus of the on-screen image, slowly move the focus ring upwards or downwards.

# **Wireless Projection**

### Via NOMVDIC AppStore

- Step 1. Go to Home > Apps Center > App Store
- Step 2. Choose the app you wish to download (e.g., Netflix, SmartTube)
- **Step 3.** After installation, log in with your account and password (a mouse or remote app is required when log in)

### Via TV Dongle



Step 2. Select the streaming service you wish to use

#### Via USB Flash Drive

- Step 1. Connect your USB flash drive to the USB-A port
- Step 2. Go to Home > File Management
- Step 3. Choose the file you wish to open

# **Cable Connected Projection**

#### Via HDMI Cable

- Step 1. Connect one end of the HDMI cable to your device (e.g., PC, laptop)
- Step 2. Connect the other end of the HDMI cable to the HDMI port on R150
- Step 3. In Home, select HDMI on the left column

#### Via USB-C Cable

- Step 1. Connect one end of the USB-C cable to your device (e.g., mobile phone, Nintendo Switch)
- Step 2. Connect the other end of the USB-C cable to the USB-C port on R150
- Step 3. In Home, select USB C on the left column

# Shutting Down the Projector

- Step 1. Press Power Button on the remote control, choose Turn Off
- Step 2. Switch the Power Toggle to OFF to turn off the projector







# Using R150 as a Bluetooth Speaker

How to pair R150 with your mobile phone for the first time

- Step 1. Go to Home > Bluetooth
- Step 2. Select Bluetooth Pairing. A sound effect will be audible upon pairing
- **Step 3.** On your phone, choose **NOMVDIC R150**. Upon successful connection, another sound effect will be audible

After the first successful pairing, you can turn on the Bluetooth speaker mode by going to **Home** > **Bluetooth**, and selecting **Bluetooth Speaker**. Your device will pair with R150 automatically.

# **FAQs**



## How do I AirPlay/Screen Mirroring the content on my phone to R150?

To connect to AirPlay or screen mirror, ensure your device is connected to the same network as the projector. It is recommended to use a 5GHz Wi-Fi network for best results.

#### For iOS

- Step 1. Access the drop-down control menu
- Step 2. Select the "Screen Mirroring" icon
- Step 3. Choose "NOMVDIC XXXX"

### For Android

- Step 1. Download and install the "Google Home" application and open it
- Step 2. Pull to refresh the app and wait for 30 seconds
- Step 3. "NOMVDIC XXXX" will now be visible, select it

Some Android devices support direct "Casting". If your device does, go to the Casting feature and choose "NOMVDIC XXXX" from the list of available devices.

Please note that AirPlay and Screen Mirroring are no longer supported by major streaming services such as Netflix and Disney+.

### How do I clean the projector?

Please refrain from forcefully pressing the buttons, as it might damage the surface and the structure of the button.

To clean the projector lens, please use a microfiber fabric to prevent scratches or damage to the surface. DO NOT use any kind of chemical cleaner. You can clean the projector body with a slightly damp towel to wipe off the dust.

#### Can I charge my projector with a power bank?

Yes, you can use a power bank to charge your projector if it has a power output of 15V/3A and supports PD protocol. Using a power source that's below 15V/3A might shorten the battery life.

#### How do I maximize the battery life?

- 1. When not using the projector, make sure the power toggle is switched to OFF. If left ON, the projector will consume the battery while in standby mode (the LED indicator will stay red when in standby mode).
- 2. Fully charge the battery at least once every three months.
